


Jewelry Making with Jennie

More Reason to Get Moving

Taking at least 3,800 steps per day is linked to a lower risk of dementia, according to a recent study published online Sept. 6, 2022, by *JAMA Neurology*.

Researchers tracked the daily steps of 78,000 healthy people, average age 61, for 34 months. Individuals wore wrist devices to record their total number of steps and how many steps they averaged per minute.

The group then was followed for seven years to see who developed dementia. Those who walked an average of 3,800 daily steps had a 25% lower risk for dementia than those who took fewer steps. The benefit increased as daily steps rose and peaked at 9,800 with no measurable gains beyond this number. Intensity offered extra protection.

Sounds like a good time to go for a walk!
