She decided to call the official government Medicare office and confirmed that the new card was good.

In recent years, fraud and scam attempts regarding Medicare cards have increased tremendously, so the Medicare office has been issuing new cards, trying to prevent further chaos. You can find answers to your Medicare questions at the official website:

Marsha's Cookie Corner

(we'll highlight a new recipe each month!)

Glazed Cinnamon Bars

- 1 cup butter
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 1 egg, <u>separated</u>, save the egg white
- 1 ¾ cup flour
- 1 Tbsp. cinnamon

Preheat oven to 350 degrees.

Combine butter, brown sugar and egg yolk and beat until creamy. Stir in flour and cinnamon, mix well. Spread into greased 13X9 in. pan. (I just spray my pan with Pam)

¹/₂ cup powdered sugar 1 cup chopped walnuts The saved egg white

Beat the egg white until foamy, blend in powdered sugar (I sift the powdered sugar first). Brush mixture over batter; sprinkle with nuts (I pat them down just a bit the help them stick to the dough).

Bake at 350 degrees 30-35 min. until nicely browned. Cut into bars while hot and remove to racks to cool.
